

Chris Heisey - Cincinnati Reds.

Chris graduated from Donegal High School in 2003 and attended Messiah College in Grantham, Pennsylvania.

While at Messiah, Chris set career leader marks for Batting Average (.405), total bases (294), doubles (41) and homeruns (23). He is the first Messiah College Alum and the first Commonwealth Conference player to make the leap to the majors.

He was drafted by the Reds in the 2006 Major League Baseball Draft.

He was added to the Reds' 40 man roster after the 2009 season.

Chris played his first major league game with the Cincinnati Reds on May 3, 2010. He got his first three major league hits, including his first home run, on May 11 in a 9-0 win against the Pirates. He made the most of his 279 at-bats in 2011, swatting 18 homers and hitting .254 with six steals, 50 RBIs and 44 runs scored.

He excelled as a pinch hitter hitting 4 Home runs to share the Major league lead in pinch hit home runs with San Diego Padres Outfielder Matt Stairs.

On June 22, 2011, Heisey hit three home runs in a game against the New York Yankees.
